As the club opens, we have a few reminders that we would like to share with you.

1. Members will need their key fobs to enter the club. If you do not have a key fob and you are a new member please contact the office and we will have them ready for you when you come for the first time. If you have lost or broken fobs you will need to purchase a new one and the cost is \$10.00.
2. When signing in, members may be asked for ID.
3. If you are carrying in an ice chest please be prepared to have it checked by either the gate keeper or manager on duty.
4. Members are allowed to bring in water and empty cups, all other beverages are strictly prohibited.
5. Children over the age of 10 are allowed at the club during regular club hours. They will need a key fob to enter the club. Please share the guidelines with them. Any unsupervised minor who is repeatedly corrected by staff or management may be asked to leave the club grounds.

6. When the Club is not officially open, members are also reminded that no one under the age of 18 is allowed on club grounds without a parent at any time.

Lakeside Country Club Summer Camp

We are now accepting registration forms for the 2021 LCC Summer Camp Program. This will be our 21st summer, and we are very excited to have your children spend their break with us. Swimming, tennis, arts & crafts, exercise, talent shows, movies, and Friday-Funday each week, are just some of the activities that campers will enjoy.

In person registration will be held on Thursday April 29th 5:30-7:00 p.m.

Summer Camp will be available from Monday, May 17th until Friday, August 13th.

Registration is open to both members & non-members whose children have completed pre-K3 through 6th grade.

There is a nonrefundable registration fee of \$50.00 per camper, which includes the cost of one camp shirt. Additional shirts may be purchased for \$10.00 each. You may also purchase a LCC Camp bag for \$15.00 at the time of registration.

Camp fees must be paid on Mondays each week with cash, check or credit card. Please note that you must complete the Credit Card Authorization Form, available on our website, if that is your preferred method of payment; and, you card will be charged on the Mondays your children attend camp.

CAMP HOURS: 8:45 AM – 3:00 PM
**Before & after care are available.*

BEFORE CARE: 7:30 AM - 8:45 AM
AFTER CARE: 3:15 PM – 5:30 PM

All forms are available on our website under summer camp, and the fees are as follows:

REGISTRATION - \$50.00 per camper

- **MEMBER RATE - \$160.00 per week** (*A 15% discount is applied for more than 1 child attending camp*)
- **NON-MEMBER RATE - \$185.00 per week** (*A 15% discount will be given for more than 1 child attending camp.*)
- **BEFORE & AFTER CARE - \$40.00 per camper each week** (*Discounts are not available for this service*)
- **CAMP BAG - \$15.00 each**

- **ADDITIONAL CAMP SHIRT - \$10.00 each**

We also offer a 3-Day program each week. Campers must be prescheduled, and no discounts apply for this program. Fees for this option are as follows:

- **MEMBER RATE- \$110.00 per week**
- **NON-MEMBER RATE - \$135.00 per week**
- **BEFORE & AFTER CARE - \$30.00 per camper each week (*Discounts are not available for this service*)**

Important Summer Camp Information

- Daily activities include swimming and group games. Weekly activities will include group games, P.E., art, tennis and music.
- All new campers may purchase a camp bag on the first day; the cost of each bag is \$15.00, if you already have a LCC Camp bag from a previous year you will not be required to purchase a new bag. Campers must bring all of their belongings in this bag every day. Please enclose a large plastic bag for their wet clothes.
- Due to time constraints, we are unable to apply sunscreen to every camper more than once a day. Sunscreen must be applied before your child reports to camp, as we will have outdoor activities early in the day. We will re-apply sunscreen throughout the day if it is needed. If your child requires special sunscreen please send in marked plastic bag.
- Girl campers are encouraged to wear one-piece bathing suits. This will eliminate the problems we have had in the past with bikinis. We also encourage all campers to wear swim shirts.
- **Campers **MUST** have tennis shoes every day!!! Campers will not be able to participate in some of the planned activities without tennis shoes.**
- Campers that will not be swimming are asked to bring a book, but will also be allowed to play games (board games, card games – not video games) and color outside during this time.
- Parents wishing to set up private swim or tennis lessons during camp time should notify the office.
- **All camp fees are due Monday morning!!!! If you chose to be invoiced for weeks you will be attending please not that on your registration form. Camp invoices will be sent out the weekend and must be paid by Monday.**

- Campers are allowed to bring their lunch or they may purchase lunch from the concession stand. The average cost of lunch is \$4.00 although older children may spend a bit more; please discuss the cost with your child before they come to camp. We will have a lunch menu available so that you can discuss choices for lunch with your child. We will also allow the children to buy 1 snack after lunch. **Campers are not allowed to buy soft drinks during camp hours.**
- LCC has a new computerized system in the concession stand. In order for your child to purchase lunch or a snack from the concession stand, you must deposit a minimum of \$50.00 into an account. All accounts MUST be prepaid and maintain a credit in order for your child to order lunch or a snack. The system WILL NOT allow an order if the account has insufficient funds.
- Please mark all of your children's belongings. Doing so curtails any mix-ups or unclaimed items.
- No camper is allowed to bring small toys to camp. These toys will be taken away and returned to the parents at the end of the day.
- **Campers are not allowed to bring their DS, iPad, Cell Phones, Switch or other such games to camp.**
- We will apply sunscreen during the day as needed. If your child requires a special brand, please send it in a Ziploc clearly marked with their name, and we will apply it as needed during the day. Please remember to apply it prior to your child's arrival at camp
- If your child requires floaties or any other swimming aids, please send them to camp marked with your child's name. There will be counselors in the pool at all times, but extra aid is always recommended. **Snorkels and masks that cover the nose are not allowed during camp!!**

Pool Rules

The pool may not be used by any person who has a communicable disease, open sores, or any other condition considered dangerous to the health and safety of others. The following are **forbidden** in the main pool, wading pool, and pool deck areas:

1. Glass in any form, except spectacles and sunglasses;
2. Food and refreshments on pool deck;
3. Boisterous or rough play in the pool area;
4. Small balls, automobile inner tubes, inflatable rafts, or any object deemed objectionable or dangerous by pool personnel in the pool area;
5. Running on the pool deck or in the bath houses;
6. Diapered babies in either the main pool or the wading pool;

These rules also apply:

1. Only one person is permitted on the diving board at a time and no excessive bouncing on the board is permitted;
2. Children under the age of 10, not sanctioned for swimming in the adult pool by a lifeguard, must be accompanied by an adult or guardian.

Added Rule: Please be advised that babies wearing special swim diapers will be allowed in the pool.

*****Please Remember that during break, children are not allowed to have any part of their body in or near the pool. The Lifeguards will strictly enforce this rule.**
